What Will They Learn in 4th Grade?

Reading and Writing

- By the end of 4th grade, your child should be able to read silently most of the time
- Recognize text structures and why they are used
- Make personal connections between texts they read
- Recognize figurative language
- Use grammar conventions to write complex sentences
- Understand spelling patterns
- Use Greek and Latin morphemes to comprehend what they are reading
- Write narrative, informational, and persuasive essays

Mathematics

- Add, subtract, multiply, and divide multidigit numbers
- Recognize the relationship between fractions and decimals
- Add and subtract fractions with like denominators
- Multiply whole numbers by fractions
- Determine area and perimeter
- Identify, compare, and classify shapes and angles based on properties
- Explain how they solved a math problem
